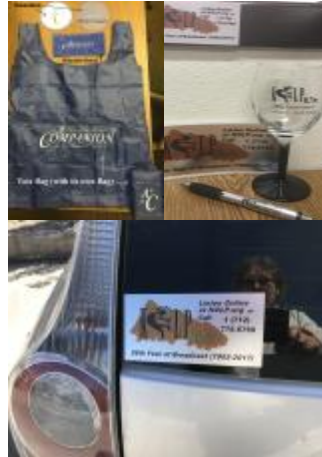
#### A Message from the Manager

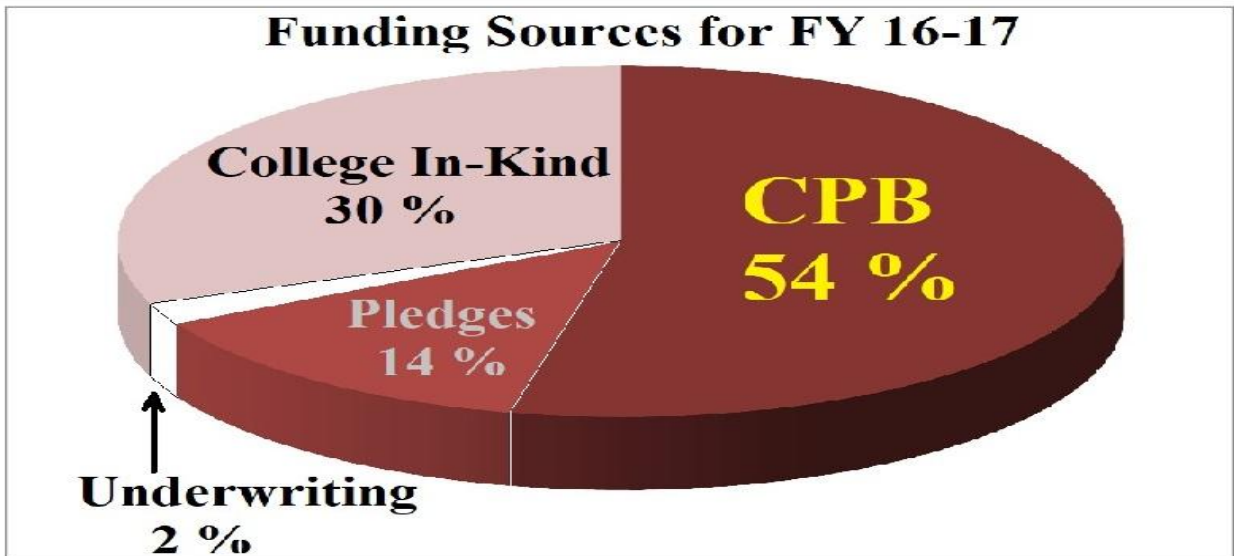

## A 25th Anniversary Message from KGLP's Manager

repeated programming from KSUT, the Southern Ute station in Ignacio, Colorado that relayed programs ranging from NPR news to Native music, while sometimes airing locally-hosted shows. Since KGLP began local origination of all programming in 2005, that diversity has continued, with syndicated programs such as Native America Calling, Making Contact, TED Radio Hour, Radio MAQAM, and Symphony-Cast, balanced by alternative offerings such as the McKinley County Metal Depot, Radio Ruminare, The Green Chile Revival and Medicine Show, Don't Worry Be Happy, Jazz shows, Kind Beat, and Blues Nation.

Frank Sundram, KGLP's first station manager, shared memories of founders such as Bill Hockensmith, the two Jacks, Crowley and Chapman, KGAK, who helped with initial fundraising efforts to get KGLP on the air, and a variety of community members such as Octavia Fellin, who helped bring public radio to Gallup while raising up the town's library. (Frank's conversation is available online at KGLP.org, on our podcast page.) A long line of volunteers, board members, supporters, and staff have kept KGLP going ever since, with this, our 25th year of broadcasting, about to be celebrated with a party and fundraiser (details are on page 9 of this newsletter.)

Fundraising has always been a necessity, given that Gallup Public Radio does not pay bills through commercials, as is the case with all non-profit broadcasters. We were blessed with a generous donation of a 1976 Toyota Land Cruiser in the Spring, which brought KGLP a check for over \$11,000, funds which went toward everything from sending myself and board president Ray Calderon to Denver in July for a community radio conference where networking connected us with Dennis Gilliam, a Phoenix-area contract engineer who we have now been able to get up to Gibson Peak for renovation of our transmitter, already resulting in a better signal, half the electricity consumption, and a reduction in operating temperature from around 105 degrees F down to around 70-75 degrees F. Dennis is coming back soon to install much-needed upgrades at our transmitter facility, which our listeners will notice whenever they tune in 91.7 FM.

Assistants Trey Chavez and Ivah Benally have continued digitizing KGLP's CD library, adding additional metadata via keyboard to provide information on each song needed for

our music playlists, essential for the requirements of quarterly music reporting, as part of our obligation for the privilege of streaming our broadcast programming online at KGLP.org - Recently, we've begun an association with Radio Free America, a 2-week audio archive service allowing our listeners to hear any local shows (and some syndicated shows) up to two weeks after live air.

Both the legacy On-Air studio "A" and our second studio "B" are now able to access the digitized music on our live-assist module, part of KGLP's automation systems, meaning that it is now possible for some show hosts and volunteers to play much of what is in our music library in Studio A without touching a CD, or getting on a step-stool to reach the upper shelves in that room. The implications for current and future show hosts who might have accessibility issues or limited mobility are apparent.

ADA accommodation is a critical need for any community broadcaster, and I still hope that, with the help of Craig Beamsley, host of "Rooted inna Reggae stylee", who is breadboarding arduinos with the help of a Raspberry Pi microcomputer, in order to prototype haptics that could enable a visually challenged engineer to monitor audio levels through changes in vibration on an armband or cuff, that we can eventually aid any organization needing better ways to integrate physically or mobility-challenged volunteers and staff into media operations.

In part to facilitate the haptics project, I anticipate crowd funding and related endeavors in order to upgrade both studios, not only to simplify use of our facilities by volunteers and staff, but to provide a more consistent workbench for our haptics project, which I believe will be a strong attribute as we expand our search for funding, given the potential for distribution to other media centers, but every dollar that you give to KGLP will help with our efforts to improve your broadcast service.

With long-time KGLP show host Lester Kien's passing in June, recruitment of new hosts continued Lester's Jazz Kind Monday nights at 9, now with Barry Klopfer, and Tuesday's 12pm "Kind Beat" world/freeform show, with Calvin Gleason and Kathleen Norton alternating, and also includes Ed Dongilly's "Radio Ruminare" Monday nights from 10 until Midnight, and Ron Donkersloot, taking over from Mike Anderson for the 10pm Thursday "Opus Jazz Hour".

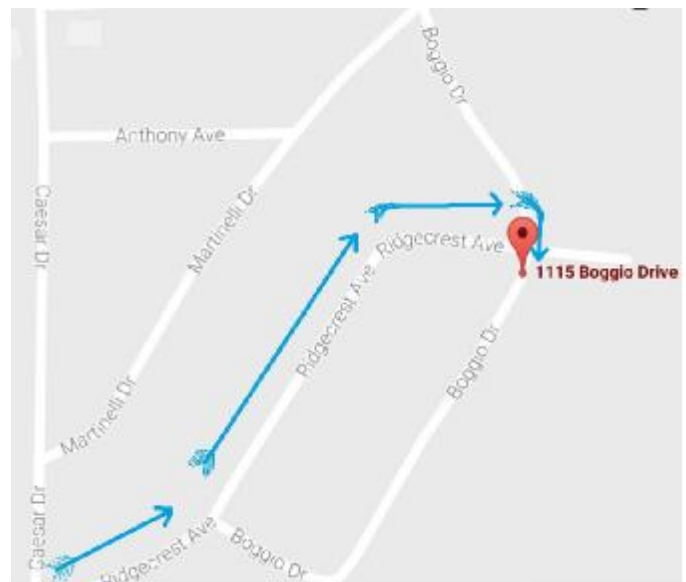
