A Message from the Manager

We still hope to replace our aging Moseley Studio-Transmitter-Link (STL), the system that conveys our programming via line-of-site microwave radio, from the University of New Mexico Gallup up to Gibson Peak. As temperatures warm up this summer, we may again hear occasional clicks, pops, and minor dropouts, and possibly disturbing some of our "tranquil" listening sessions.

## News from the Board

### Board Update

All four current Board Members who were on the January ballot continue on Gallup Public Radio's Board of Directors, with Adjua Adjei-Danso, Katherine Belzowski,

We believe that the installation of a new STL system will better convey audio from our UNMG studios up to our Gibson Peak transmitter. The cost for purchase and installation is now projected in the range of around \$20,000, in order to lock in a licensed, well-protected frequency that no other entity can "step on" or interfere with in the future, ensuring 15-20 years, minimum, of sustained use.

With that in mind, Gallup Public Radio Board Member Dr. Terrence Sloan is again hosting a fundraiser for KGLP, (*continues on page 6*)

If you would like to chat with board or show hosts, consider RSVP'ing or just drop by the April 17th Signal Clean-up Party in Dr. Sloan's backyard.

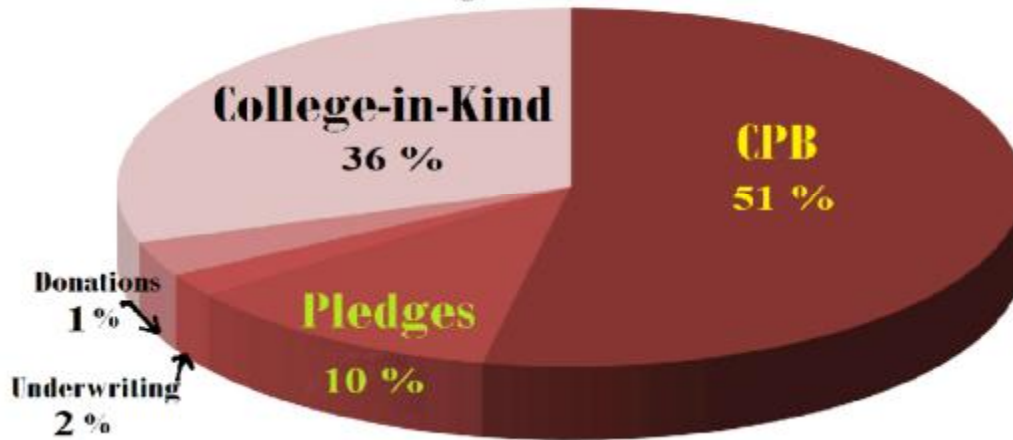

If you know the way, you can drop by Wednesday evening, at your convenience.)

KGLP's April 17th "Signal Clean-Up Party" strives to jumpstart funds toward improving our on-air signal, paying for new equipment, and maintaining cash flow for routine bills and general equipment repairs or replacement. There will be refreshments such as wine, cheese, Salmon, crackers, non-alcoholic beverages, a silent (mostly art) auction, and a return engagement by classical guitarist Liam Murphy, whose soothing performances have always been noteworthy.

We'll continue with our Spring Campaign over the coming months, hoping again for more of you to become sustaining members, signing up online for monthly donations through credit, PayPal, or bank transfer, to serve our listeners, the community of Gallup and surrounding areas such as Bread Springs, Churchrock, Tohatchi, Houck, Thoreau, and parts of other communities such as Window Rock, Ft. Defiance, St. Michaels, Ramah, and Zuni.

Cash flow has always been important, as provided by our donors and members. Additionally, our funding from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting is contingent on sufficient matching funds, such as from our

listeners. You help sustain our grant funding with every dollar given to Gallup Public Radio.

We still have a few 25th (Silver) Anniversary stickers, and new "Green-Edition" 25th Anniversary pens, while supplies last, available upon request with your contribution. 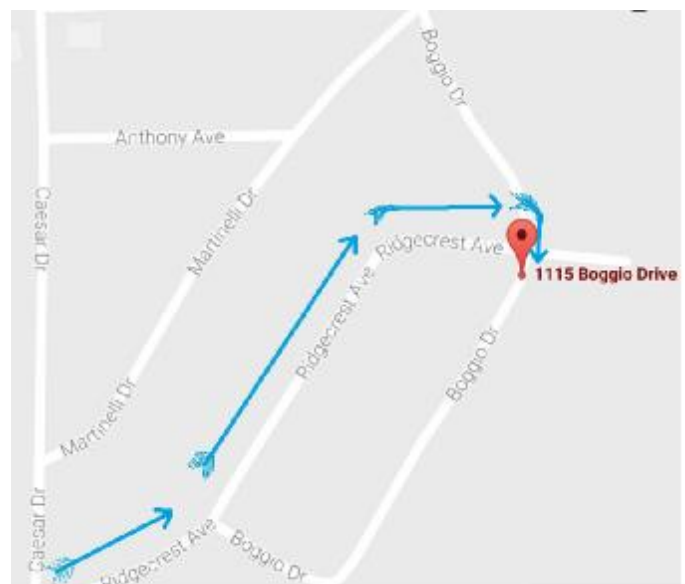
## You are Invited !!
